This was the first time the event had been run in person since the pandemic. There was a full turnout by 50+ attendees from the Manchester deal-doing community. The general feeling of the co-hosts and the panel members was that there is a plentiful supply of many different types of funding in the north west to fuel deal activity, without needing to go to London. The panel agreed that the last 9 months have seen an increasing sense of caution by business owners due to the series of external 'shocks to the system' but a general feeling that the M&A funding market in the north west has been remarkably resilient.

For the first time since this annual event started in 2016 ESG was raised as an increasingly important feature of deals.
